



MEMO FOR PASSENGERS



Person(s) exporting/importing prescribed medical drugs containing potent, narcotic and psychotropic substances **MUST FILL IN A PASSENGER'S CUSTOMS DECLARATION** and be in possession of **RELEVANT MEDICAL DOCUMENTS** such as a prescription or a certificate from the doctor and an extract from their medical record.



Person(s) exporting/importing weapons, their major parts and ammunition **MUST FILL IN A PASSENGER'S CUSTOMS DECLARATION** and be in possession of a **CORRESPONDING PERMISSION** from an internal affairs authority.



Person(s) exporting cultural valuables **MUST FILL IN A PASSENGER'S CUSTOMS DECLARATION** and be in possession of a **PERMIT FOR EXPORTING** cultural valuables issued by the Ministry of Culture of the Russian Federation.



Person(s) exporting rare and endangered species of animals and wild plants, their parts and derivatives **MUST FILL IN A PASSENGER'S CUSTOMS DECLARATION** and be in possession of a **PERMIT** issued by the **FEDERAL SERVICE FOR SUPERVISION OF NATURAL RESOURCES (ROSPIRODNADZOR)**.



Items intended for personal use transported by **AIR TRANSPORT** may be imported **DUTY-FREE** if their value **DOES NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT EQUIVALENT TO EUR 10,000** and if their **TOTAL WEIGHT** does not exceed **50 kilos**.



Items intended for personal use transported by **OTHER MEANS OF TRANSPORT** may be imported **DUTY-FREE** if their value **DOES NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT EQUIVALENT TO EUR 1,500** and if their **TOTAL WEIGHT** does not exceed **50 kilos**.



A person aged 18 or older may import not more than **3 LITERS** of alcoholic beverages and beer **DUTY-FREE**.



A person aged 18 or older may import the following tobacco goods **DUTY-FREE**: **200 CIGARETTES** or **50 CIGARS** or **250 grams** of **TOBACCO**, or any of these assorted items if their **TOTAL WEIGHT** does not exceed **250 grams**.



CASH and **TRAVELLER'S CHEQUES** may be imported **DUTY-FREE** if their total value **DOES NOT EXCEED USD 10,000**.



EXPORT OF FOLLOWING ITEMS FROM THE CUSTOMS TERRITORY OF THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION IS FORBIDDEN:

- more than 5 kg of fish and sea products;
- more than 250 grams of sturgeon caviar;
- more than 10 liters of fuel contained in an individual tank.
